Corpus Christi - The Most Holy Body & Blood of Christ 3 June 2018

Corpus Christi is the yearly feast celebrating the Real Presence of Jesus Christ, in His Body and Blood, in the bread and wine of the Eucharist, where we welcome Him with joy.

In 1208 AD Christ appeared to St Juliana of Liege requesting a feast in honor of His gift of his Precious Body and Blood to us. The Church took up Christ's request brought forward by St Juliana. Though today its official name is "The Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ", people still know this day by its first name, "Corpus Christi" - *Body of Christ*.

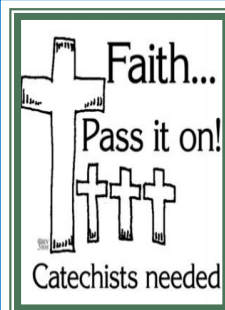

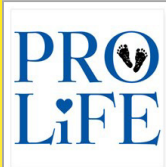

As A U.S. Citizen, Be Thankful For Your Life!

In the United States, there is no federal criminal law governing abortion at any phase of pregnancy. As it stands today, American women have the legal right to obtain an abortion in all 50 states, through all nine months of pregnancy, for virtually any reason (or no reason) at all.

America has one of the most liberal abortion laws in the world...for example, far more liberal than western Europe.

In Germany, women seeking first-trimester abortions are subject to a mandatory three-day waiting period and a counseling session. Abortions after the first 12 weeks of pregnancy are forbidden except in cases of grave threat to the mother's physical or mental health. The Netherlands mandates a five-day waiting period between initial consultation and abortion; clinics must provide women with information about abortion alternatives.

If you are less than 40 years old and are reading this bulletin article, you are lucky to be alive! You had a 33% chance of being aborted BEFORE you left your mother's womb. So, give your mom and dad a big hug and kiss, and thank them for choosing LIFE, especially YOUR LIFE!
