Mondays, November 7, 14, 21, 28; 10-11:30 am

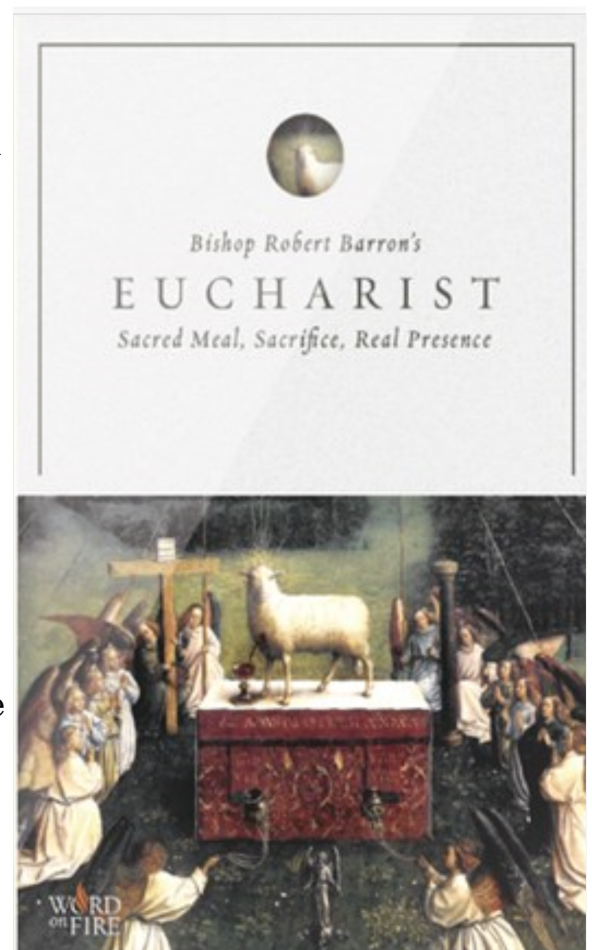
