Fasting must be observed on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday by those between the ages 18 and 58. Fasting means only **one full meal** may be eaten. Two small meals/snacks that do not add up to a full meal may also be had.

The Fish means this is a **Day of Abstinence** which must be observed by everyone 14 years and older. On these days we do not eat meat or poultry. We may substitute another sacrifice if we already do not eat meat or poultry (for example, vegetarians), or for reasons of health. See the bulletin for more information.
