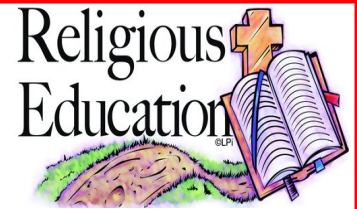

Upcoming Bible Study

Bible Study with Rick McCormick. Registration for an eleven week study of the Letters *to the Romans and Galatians* will begin after mass on Sundays 14 & 21 August, in Harrington Hall. Please see Peggy McCormick after mass on one of these two dates to sign up for the Bible Study and pay the fee for the textbook we will be using. The textbooks, from the Liguori Catholic Bible Study series, will be ordered on 22 August so please pay the textbook fee of \$15.00 no later than 21 August. Couples may share one book if desired. The Reverend William A. Anderson, DMin, PhD is the author of this wonderful series. In this study we will examine "the primary issue Paul addresses [which] is how to assimilate the Old and New covenants". The eleven week Bible Study will begin on Wednesday, September 7th and continue through to Wednesday, November 16th. Rick is offering two sessions each Wednesday. The morning sessions begin at 9:00 a.m. and end at 10:30 a.m. The Wednesday evening sessions begin at 7:00 p.m. and end at 8:30 p.m. You may phone Rick at 678-6373 if you need additional information, or have questions on this course of study.
