WEEK OF PRAYER FOR CHRISTIAN UNITY JANUARY 18 - 25

Following an over - 100 year tradition, the Catholic Church joins with brother and sister Christians this January in praying that "all may be one" - the prayer of Jesus at the Last Supper (*John 17:21*). The *Week of Prayer for Christian Unity* began with a group of Anglican Franciscans in upstate New York in 1908. In 1916, Pope Benedict XV committed the Catholic Church to the observance. The theme for 2017 - the 500th anniversary of the Reformation - is "Reconciliation - The Love of Christ Compels Us" (*2 Corinthians 5:14 - 20*), celebrating the saving justification of men and women through God's grace alone.

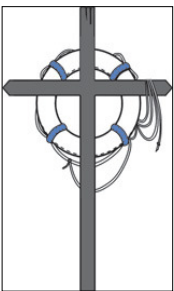
