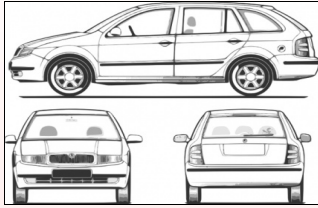

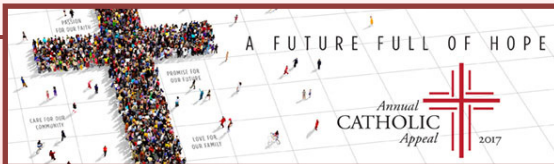

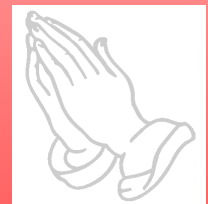
Adoration after Thursday Mass has been put on hold for the Summer. It will resume in September.
