

SANTO NIÑO DE CEBU

SATURDAY, JANUARY 20 5:00 pm Mass & 6:00 PM Reception

The Santo Niño de Cebu is a Roman Catholic title of the Child Jesus. It is associated with the religious image of the Christ Child widely venerated as miraculous by Filipino Catholics.

It is the oldest Christian artifact in the Philippines, originally a gift from the Spanish conquistador Ferdinand Magellan to a Filipino ruler and his wife on the occasion of their Christian baptism in 1521.

Everyone is invited to a Potluck reception in the Parish Hall following the Mass.
