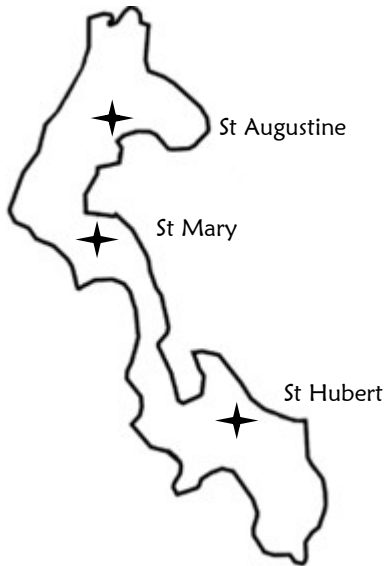

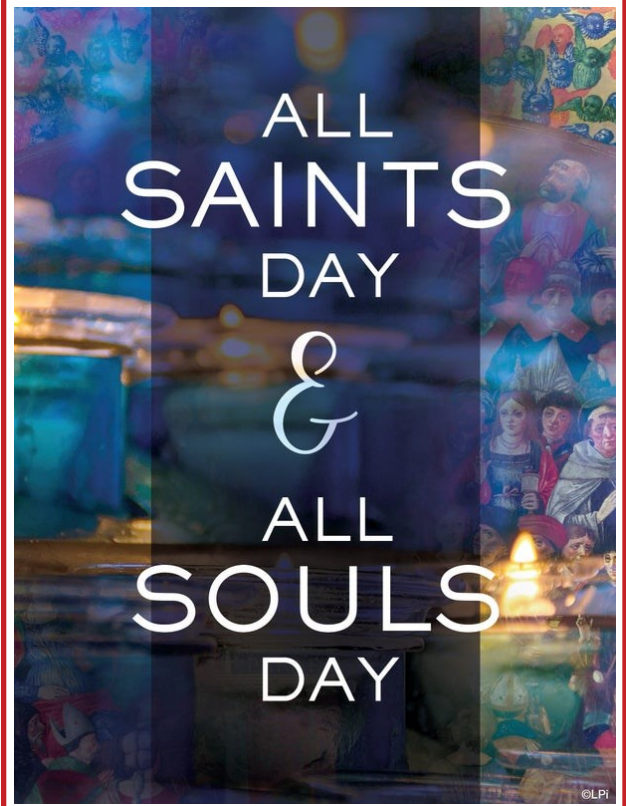
Sacraments

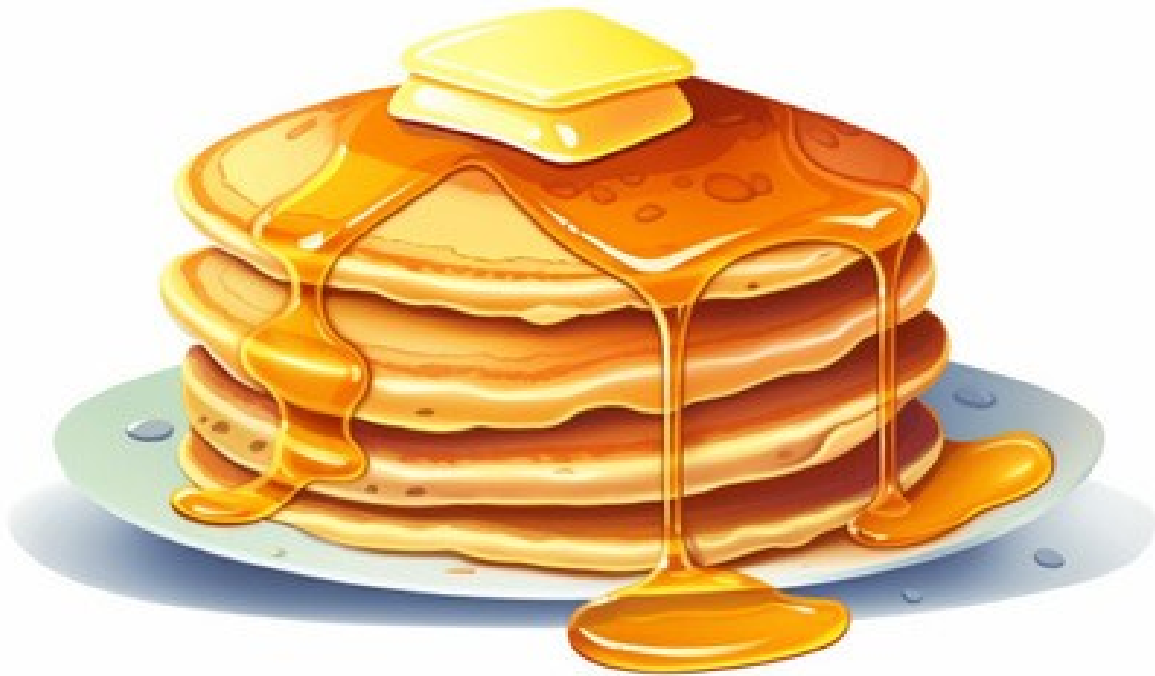

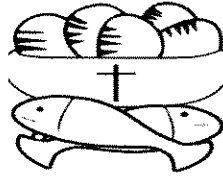
