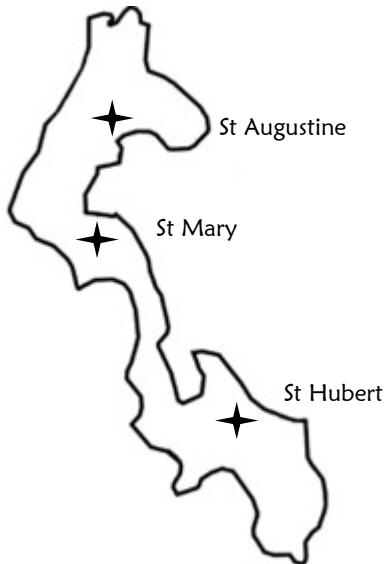

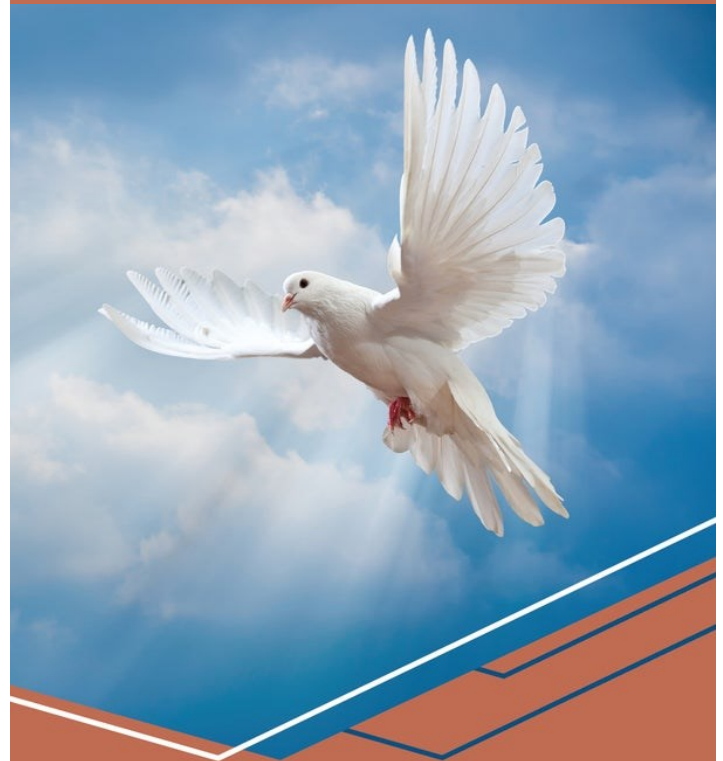

Tips and Etiquette

The Feast of the Dedication of the Lateran Basilica celebrates the anniversary of the Dedication of Rome's Lateran Basilica in 324 A.D. In that year,

Pope Sylvester established his cathedral and residence on property given to the Church by the Emperor Constantine. As the Cathedral of the Bishop of Rome and the Pope, it is the highest-ranking church in the world. The Lateran Basilica is known as the "Mother of all the Churches of Rome and of the world," as inscribed in Latin on the basilica's facade. It is thus ranked first and most important of the four major basilicas in Rome, as well, and, owing to its preeminence, it is also uniquely an archbasilica.

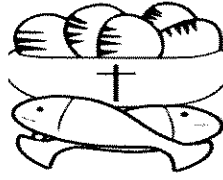
Gratitude starts when we recognize
