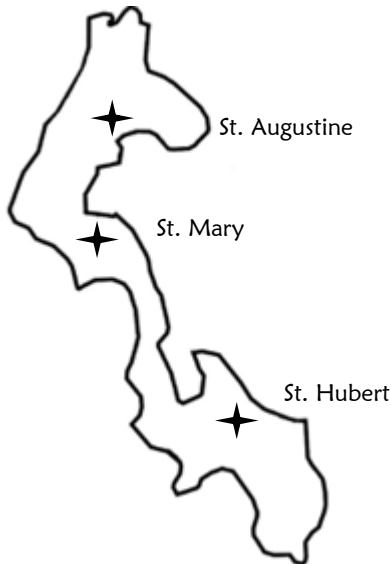

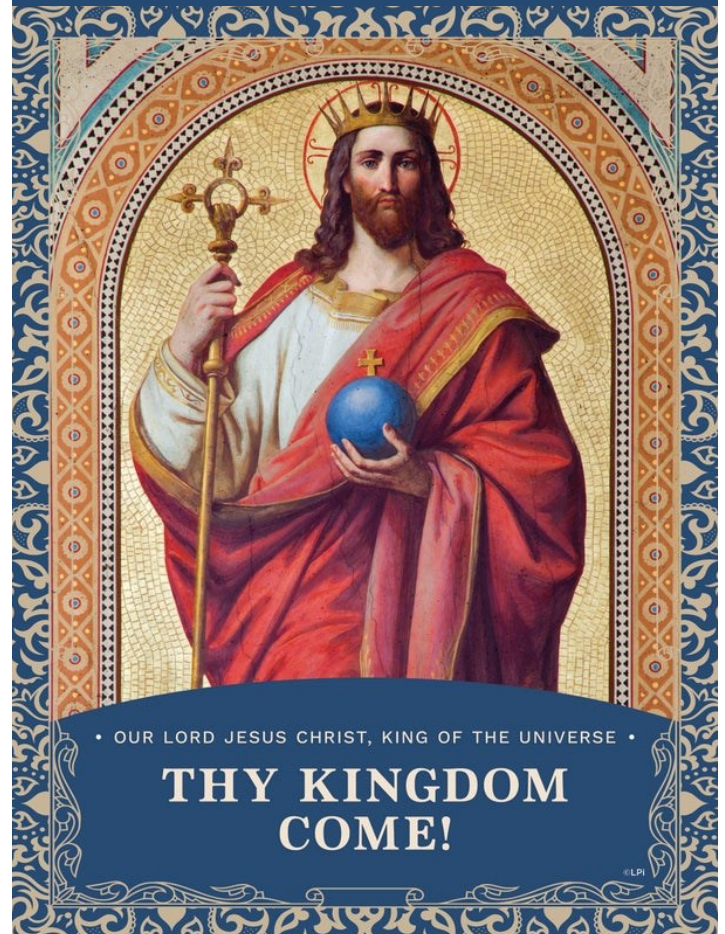

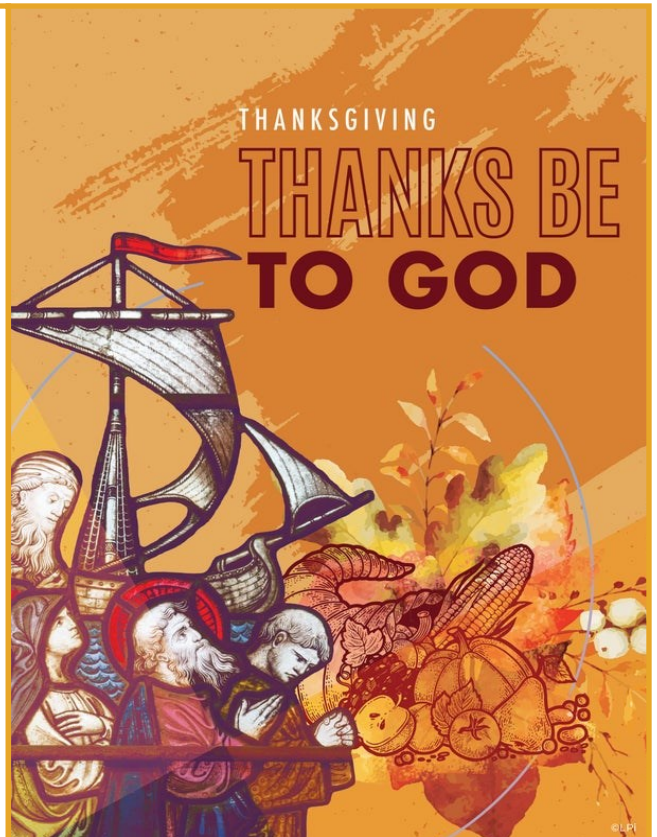
Sacraments
