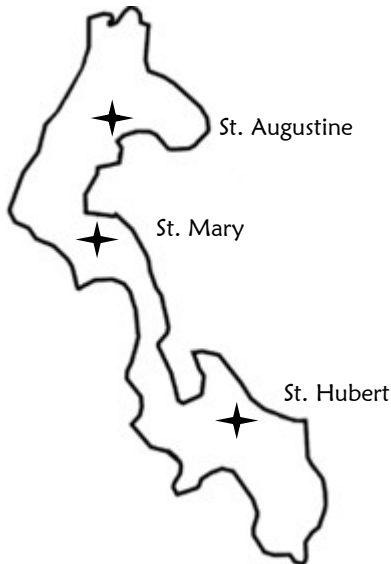

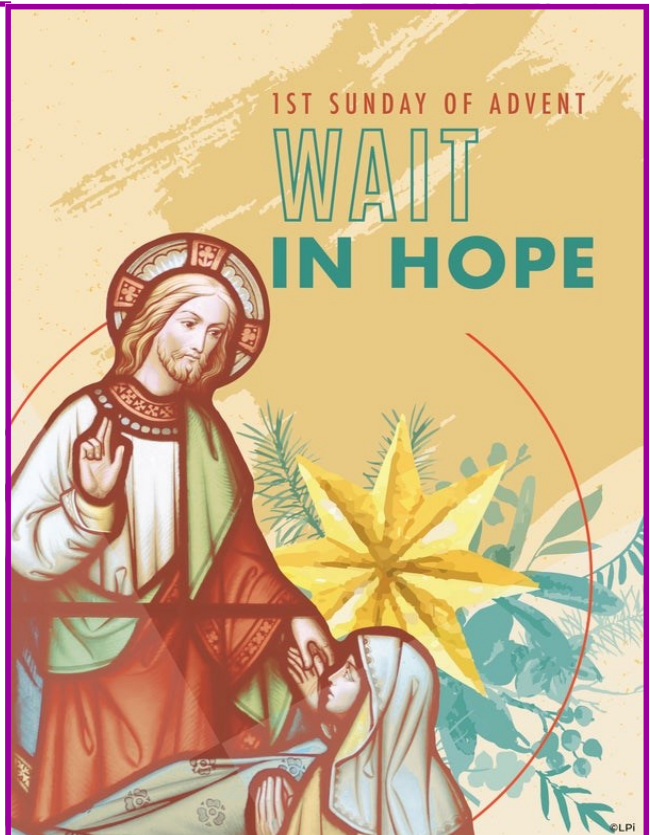
Sacraments

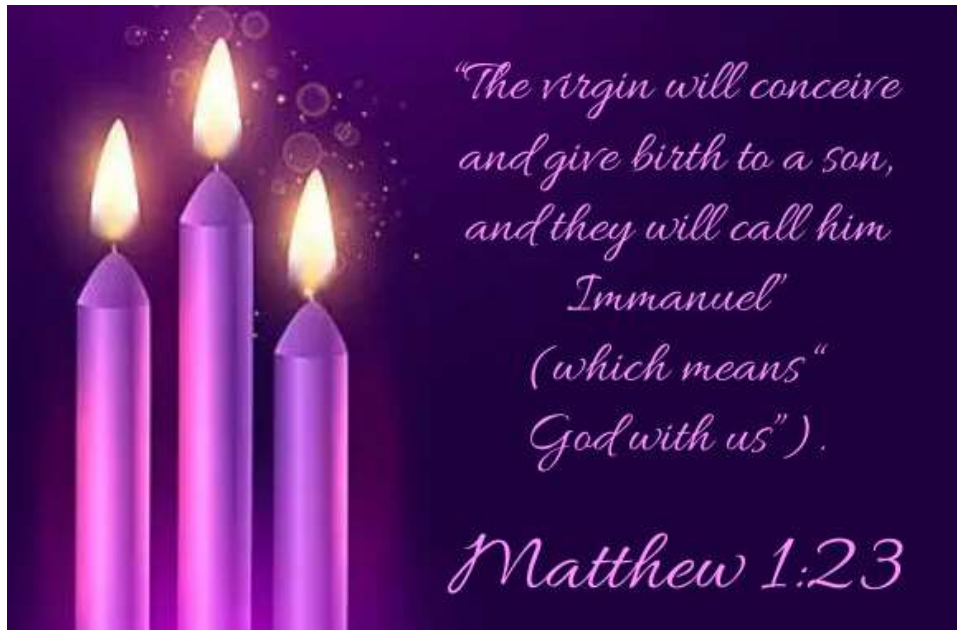
