


## Sacraments

## Tips and Etiquette

Children are a blessing at Mass, bringing vitality to our worship community. To foster reverence, parents can prepare kids by explaining the liturgy and setting gentle expectations. If babies cry or kids fidget, calmly step out to the vestibule or cry room until settled. Avoid snacks or toys that distract or make noise; instead, whisper explanations or hold hands to engage them. This approach honors the sacred space while teaching faith, as the Church welcomes families. A supportive word to a parent of little ones is always appreciated and welcome. With patience, children learn to participate, enriching the Mass experience for all.



## *Baptism of the Lord*

This week, I watched a child gaze at a starlit sky, her wonder opening my eyes to hidden beauty. This echoed Epiphany's Gospel, where wise men follow a star to worship the child King, revealing God's light to all nations (Matthew 2:1-12). The Catechism teaches, "The Epiphany is the manifestation of Jesus as Messiah of Israel, Son of God and Savior of the world" (CCC 528), a revelation calling us to adoration. That child's awe felt like God's invitation.




I recall my own moments of doubt, seeking signs, only to find them in baptismal waters. The Catechism adds, "Baptism is the principal place for the first and fundamental conversion" (CCC 1226), as in Luke's Gospel where heaven opens at Jesus' baptism (Luke 3:21-22). The dove and voice reminded me: renewal flows from divine affirmation. That starlit gaze taught me epiphanies lead to mission.

In our ordinary time, let us seek Christ's light. May prayer and sacraments renew us, guiding our journeys to eternal glory.
