


Sacraments

Last week, I sat with a friend lamenting his endless pursuit of a bigger house, his voice heavy with exhaustion. This echoed today's Gospel, where a man seeks Jesus to divide an inheritance, prompting the Parable of the Rich Fool (Luke 12:16-21). The fool hoards his harvest, planning leisure, only to hear, "This night your life will be demanded of you" (Luke 12:20). His wealth, unshared, proves futile. This challenges us to ponder: What am I storing up? Jesus calls us to a richer treasure—faith in God's kingdom.

The Psalm today pleads, "Teach us to number our days that we may gain a heart of wisdom" (Psalm 90:12), a wisdom the fool lacked, clinging to possessions over purpose. In prayer, I've felt

the pull to accumulate, yet the Spirit nudges me toward generosity. The rich man's error wasn't wealth but his self-reliance, blind to eternity's call. This parable invites us to detach, offering our abundance to others as Christ did.

In our material world, let us seek God's heart, not hoarded goods. May we use our resources to bless the poor, finding true wealth in love and service. Each Eucharist reminds us: earthly riches fade, but divine love endures. Let this truth guide us, transforming our lives into offerings of praise until we rest in God's eternal home.




