



This morning, I noticed a neighbor searching her yard for a runaway dog, her face a mix of worry and hope. This scene echoed today's Gospel, where Jesus shares the shepherd's joy over a lost sheep, the woman's delight in finding her coin, and the father's embrace of his prodigal son (Luke 15:4-7, 8-10, 11-32).

The Catechism states, "Conversion to Christ... involves a turning from sin and a return to the Father" (CCC 1423), mirrored in the father's unconditional love. That search felt familiar.

I've wandered too, chasing fleeting pleasures, only to find peace in returning to faith. The Catechism adds, "If we say we have no sin, we deceive ourselves" (CCC 2841), yet God's mercy awaits. The older son's bitterness once reflected my heart, but the father's welcome teaches forgiveness. That dog's return reminded me: God seeks us with relentless love.

In our distracted lives, let us seek and forgive. May prayer and compassion guide us, transforming our strivings into the Father's joyful embrace.


