## Tips and Etiquette

The nave, the main body of the church where the congregation sits or stands in the church pews, is a sacred space for prayer and worship. Whether during Mass or visiting quietly, maintain reverence by entering with a genuflection toward the tabernacle, keeping silence to respect others' prayer, and avoiding distractions like phones or loud conversations. Conversations belong in the vestibule. This honors Christ's presence in the Eucharist, fostering a prayerful atmosphere for all. Even outside Mass, treat the nave as God's house, inviting quiet reflection and adoration.

## *“Behold, the Lamb of God.”*

Last week, I heard a friend testify in court, his honest words shifting the room's tension to truth. This echoed today's Gospel, where John the Baptist points to Jesus, saying, “Behold, the Lamb of God, who takes away the sin of the world” (John 1:29). The Catechism teaches, “Jesus is the Lamb who takes away the sin of the world” (CCC 608), a sacrifice John recognizes through the Spirit's descent. That courtroom moment felt like God's revelation.

I recall my own silences, fearing to speak truth, only to find freedom in witness. The Catechism adds, “John the Baptist is the immediate precursor of Jesus, sent to prepare his way” (CCC 719), his testimony bridging old and new covenants. The dove's descent reminded me: the Spirit confirms our calls. That friend's courage taught me testimony transforms lives.

In our ordinary time, let us bear witness to Christ. May prayer and honesty shape us, leading others to the Lamb's redemptive love.
