

Salt and Light in Our World

As disciples of Christ, we are called to be the salt of the earth and the light of the world—preserving goodness and illuminating truth amid darkness.

Lord Jesus, empower us to be courageous instruments of Your light and grace. Amen.




Anticipating the Cross with Saint Ignatius: A Silent Retreat


