- ∞ After 4pm Tuesday-Friday or Saturday/Sunday, call the office at 360-675-2303 and listen to the message to receive the **emergency anointing or last rites only** phone number.

The Vatican flag and the flag of the United States near the sanctuary reflect both our unity with the Church and our call to faithful citizenship. The Vatican flag signifies communion with the Holy Father and the universal Church. The American flag reminds us to pray for our nation, especially in light of its consecration to the Sacred Heart of Jesus, entrusting our country to His love and mercy. These flags are clean, upright, and placed respectfully near the sanctuary, but never on the altar. Their presence is not decorative, but a reminder to live the Gospel faithfully in both Church and society.

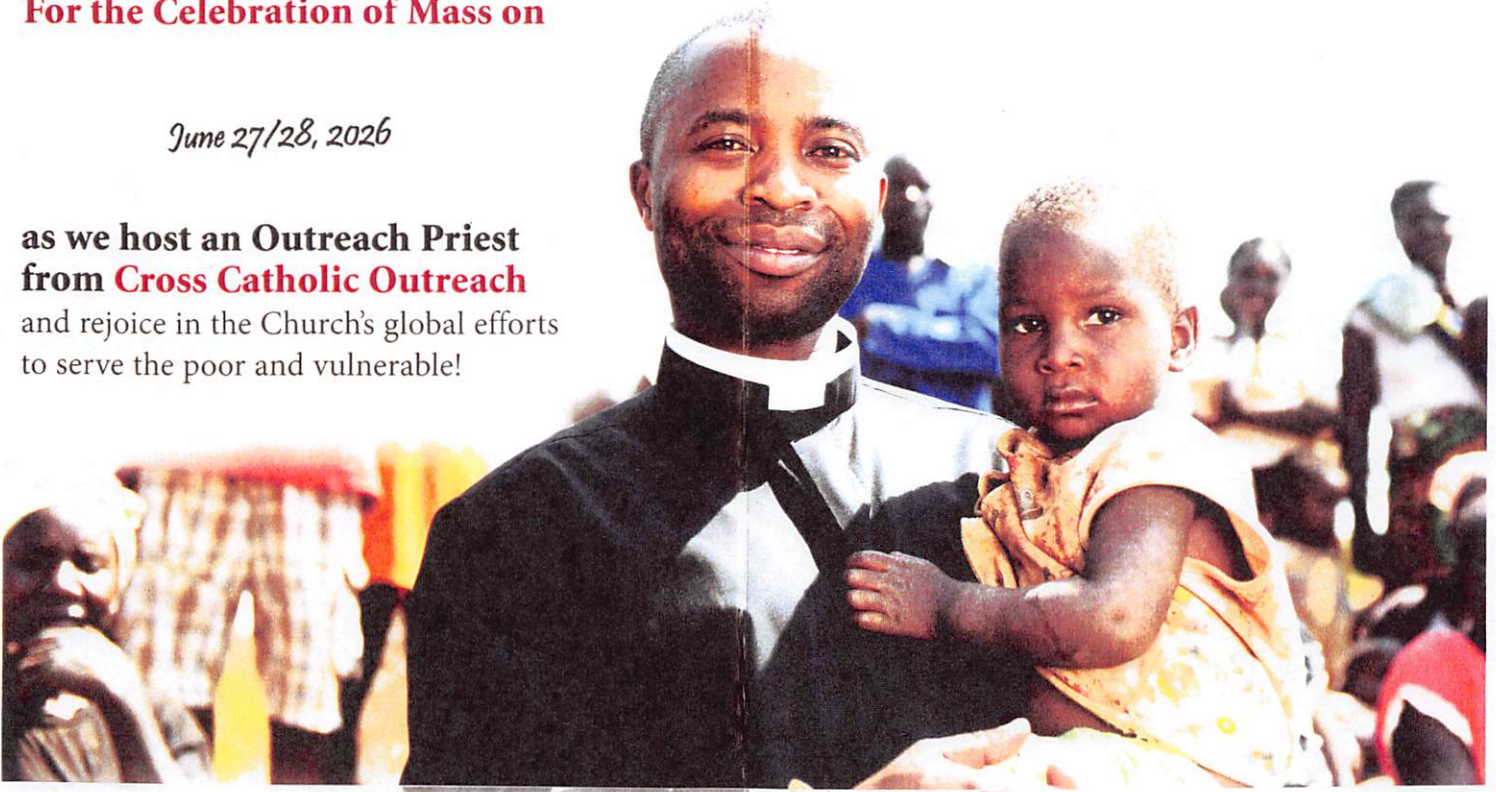
