

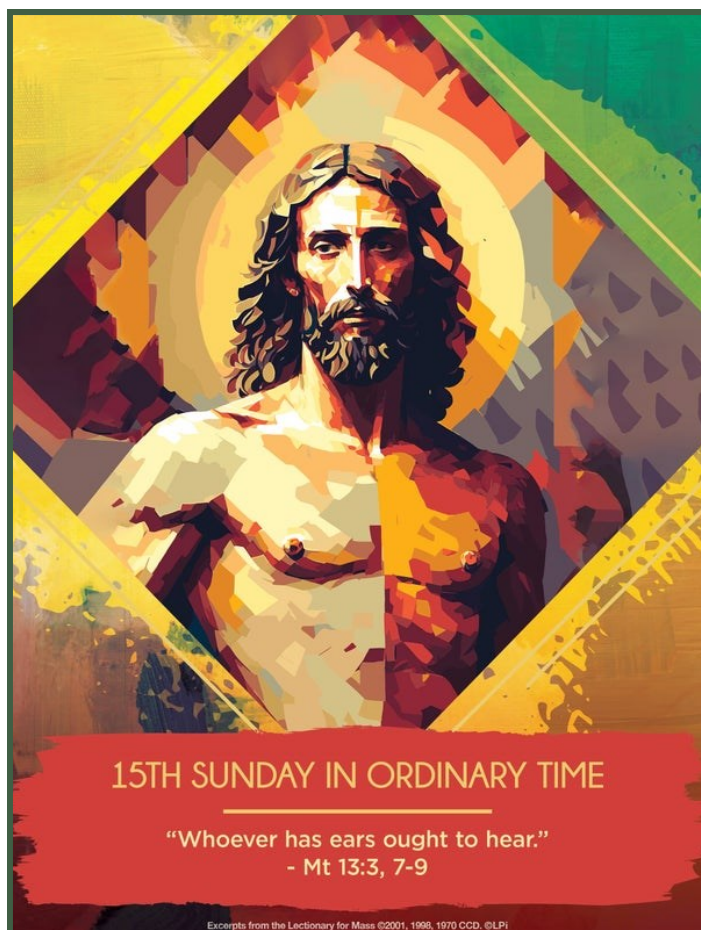
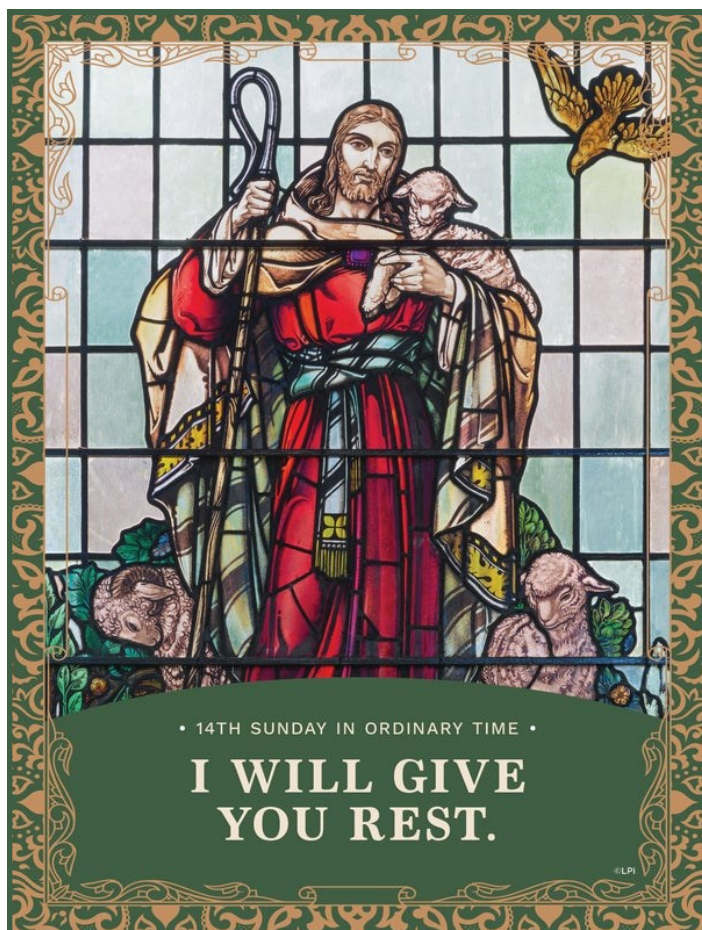

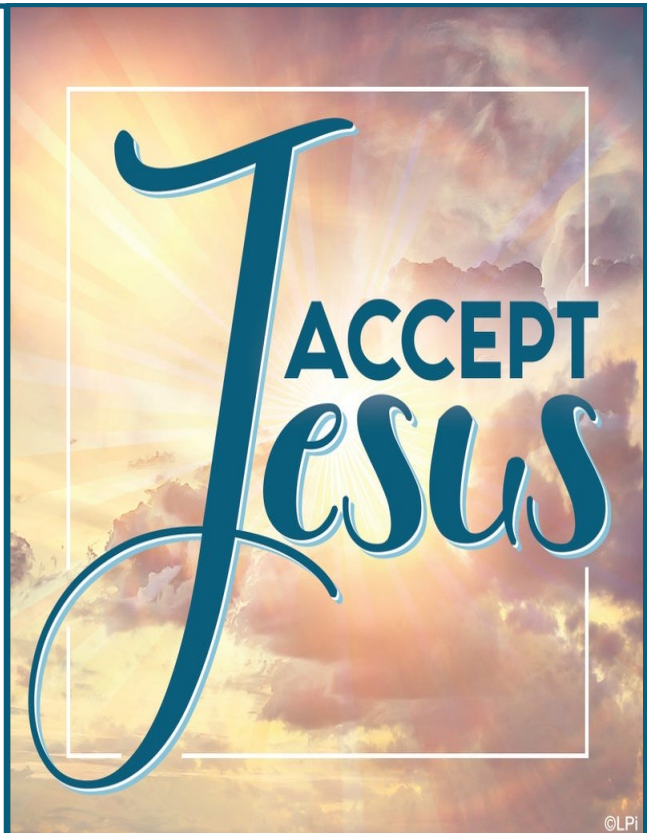
Sacraments

Baptisms:

Anointings:

- ∞ On any Monday, please call another parish to request an anointing.
- ∞ Please call the parish office at 360-675-2303 on Tuesday - Friday from 10:00 am - 4:00pm to request an anointing or last rites.
- ∞ After 4pm Tuesday-Friday or Saturday/Sunday, call the office at 360-675-2303 and listen to the message to receive the **emergency anointing or last rites only** phone number.

Tips & Etiquette

Lighting a candle in the Church is a sacred sign of prayer and devotion, symbolizing the light of Christ and our intentions offered to God. When approaching the candle stand, do so quietly and reverently, mindful of others in the nave who are praying. Take care to light your candle safely using the provided match., lighter, or stick. Candles are typically lit before or after Mass, not during the liturgy. Avoid haste or distraction, allowing the moment to be one of peaceful prayer. Each flame represents a faithful offering, a visible reminder of hope, trust, and the abiding presence of Christ among us.

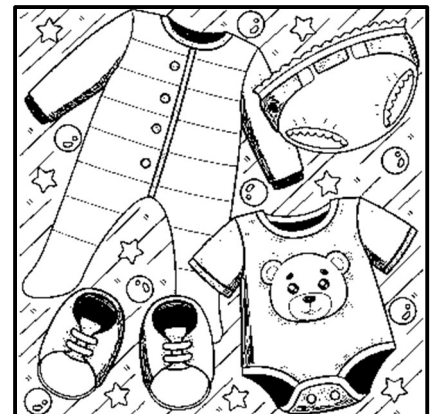

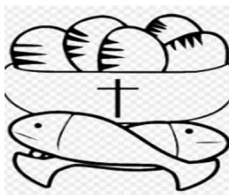
